## USGA RULES GOVERN PLAY

 EXCEPT WHEREMODIFIED BYA LOCAL RULE- KEEP GOLF CARS OUT OF NATIVE GRASS AND OFF ANY MOUNDS AT ALL TIMES.
- Out of Bounds is defined by White Stakes and/or boundary fence. A ball is considered Out of Bounds when all of it lies Out of Bounds. Rule 27.
- Lateral Hazards are identified by Red Stakes. Water Hazards are identified by Yellow Stakes. Rule 26.
- All yardages measured to the Center of the Green.
- For daily pin placements please refer to the sign located at the 1st Tee.
- Golf car boundaries are defined by small white stakes with black tops. No carts past these points - Follow stakes to cart paths.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

- Repair Ball Marks, Replace Divots, and Rake Traps.
- Cross fairways at a $90^{\circ}$ angle and keep on paths around all Tees and Greens.
- Observe all posted rules and regulations.
- Allow faster players to play through.
- Keep pace with the group in front of you and not slightly ahead of the group behind you.
